2 Hearty Slow Cooker Recipes

Spicy Slow Cooked Pork

The smoked paprika gives this casserole an intense, quite fiery flavour - just the thing to keep you warm on a chilly night.

Serves: 4 Prep Time: less than 30 mins

Ingredients

2 leeks, sliced

175g button mushrooms

250ml chicken stock

1 carrot, peeled and sliced

2 garlic cloves, chopped

1 can chopped tomatoes

1 tbsp paprika

1/2 tbsp smoked paprika

1 red chilli, de-seeded and finely chopped

Low calorie cooking spray

700g lean braising pork, cut into 2.5cm cubes

Method

- Heat a frying pan and spray with a little low calorie cooking spray. Brown the pork in batches for about 5 minutes until golden all over.
- Place the leeks, carrot, mushrooms, garlic, chicken stock, tomatoes, paprika and chilli in a saucepan. Bring to the boil and simmer for 10 minutes.
- Transfer into the slow-cooker and pour over the contents of the saucepan. Cover with the lid and cook on 'low' for 5-6 hours or until the pork is tender.
- Taste and season with salt and pepper if necessary. Serve with rice and vegetables

Vegetable & Lentil Casserole

Warm up in the cooler months with our hearty and comforting casserole.

Serves: 4 Prep Time: 10 mins


Ingredients

Chopped onion, celery, carrots, potatoes, parsnips, swede and leeks - 850ml vegetable stock - 113g red lentils - 1 tsp paprika, cumin, coriander and crushed mustard seeds - Salt and pepper - Low calorie cooking spray

Method

- Heat a large pan sprayed with low calorie cooking spray. Add the onions and fry for 5-6 minutes until lightly browned.
- Spray your slow cooker with low calorie cooking spray and add the onions and chopped vegetables, stock, spices and lentils. Stir well and cook on 'medium' for 5-6 hours.
